NOTES

- 1. 'H' = Hunstanton in the county of Norfolk, England. The H/S swim is a South to North direction of swim. 'S' = Skegness in the county of Lincolnshire, England. S/H is a North to South swim. * It is known that Mercedes Gleitze's swim in 1929 finished in Heacham, but it is not known where she started from. ** It is known that Kevin Murphy's swim in 1974 started in Skegness and finished in Holme.
- 2. Mercedes Gleitze (b. 1900, d. 1981) was the first person and therefore the first woman known to have swum The Wash. The swim is recorded in the records of West Norfolk District Council and on the sign pictured right which was commissioned by the council to celebrate the 75th anniversary of her swim on June 20, 2004. It has never been erected due to her surname being spelt incorrectly (Gleiz instead of Gleitze).
- 3. The swims of Tina Spry, Kevin Murphy and Michael (Mike) Read were completed when all swimmers were members of The former 'Channel Swimming Association' which was established in 1927 to ratify swims of The English Channel. All swims were completed in accordance with the rules of the then Channel Swimming Association which was superseded as an organisation in 1999 by The Channel Swimming Association Limited. Mike Read's swims were observed by The Skegness Lifeboat crew. The swims were ratified by the British Long Distance Swimming Association (BLDSA).
- 4. On Tuesday November 03, 2009 Kevin Murphy confirmed that Tina Spry was Kevin's protégé and accompanied him on an attempt on 26/05/1974 when he passed out unconscious after 8 hours 40 minutes with hypothermia. The water temperature was 52 degrees Fahrenheit. Tina went on to complete the swim in 8 Hours 36 Minutes. She used it as a training swim for an unsuccessful English Channel swim the same year.
- 5. Where the seconds have been recorded for a swim (Kevin Murphy 1973 & Mike Read's 2-way swim in 1975) they are shown in the times accordingly. Where the seconds are not known, ":00" has been added to the known times for consistency of layout.
- 6. This inaugural list of swims was compiled on November 06, 2009 by The Chairman of IOWSA, Paul Hopfensperger, following a visit to Hunstanton on September 26, 2009 and meetings with representatives of West Norfolk District Council and by telephone conversations with Kevin Murphy, Mike Read and records from Kevin Murphy and Mike Read's internet pages, newspaper cuttings from Kevin Murphy and the internet in general.
